Program Requirements

A minimum total of 120 credit hours is required for the BA in English. The major consists of 33 credit hours, only 3 credits of which may be at the 200 level. In addition to meeting the requirements of the WSU General Education Program (<http://catalog.wichita.edu/undergraduate/academic-information/general-education-program/>) and the requirements of the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, students in the BA in English must complete the distributed coursework as follows:
