## ProgramRequirements

A minimum total of 120 credit hours is required for the BA in MCLL - bilingual option (BI-OP). In addition to meeting the requirements of the WSU General Education Program (http://catalog.wichita.edu/ undergraduate/academic-information/general-education-program/) and the requirements of Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, students must meet the following requirements:

${ }^{1}$ Required major courses may also count towards General Education and/or LAS Competencies. Students will need to select additional electives to reach 120 credit hours required for graduation with assistance from an advisor.
${ }^{2}$ Option available to students who choose French, Latin or Spanish as one of their languages.

## Applied Leaming

Students in the BA in modern and classical languages/bilingual option are required to complete an applied learning or research experience to graduate from the program. The requirement can be met by successfully completing MCLL 351 Linguistics and World Languages, which involves an applied component such as sociolinguistics or semiotics, a discipline that involves applied linguistics.
