MEd in Sport Management

Admission

Admission to the master's degree program in sport management is considered for students who have completed an earned undergraduate degree from a regionally accredited institution with a grade point average of 2.750 (4.000 system), in their cumulative undergraduate work. Candidate evaluations are based on:

1. GPA of at least 2.750 (4.000 system) in their undergraduate coursework and faculty evaluation based on resume submission.

Admission to the program is competitive, and candidates are encouraged to apply as soon as possible for preference in their desired semester of entry. For more information, please contact the Graduate Program Coordinator, Dr. Mike Ross at mike.ross@wichita.edu.

Program Requirements

The MEd program in sport management requires 30 credit hours — 24 credit hours of required coursework and a 6-credit hour internship. In addition, the program requires that all students pass a final comprehensive examination covering all required coursework during their final semester prior to graduation.
