

Accelerated Bachelor's to Master's in Mechanical Engineering

Program Requirements

The accelerated bachelor's to master's degree (ABMS) is designed to offer outstanding students the opportunity for advancing their careers by pursuing the bachelor's and master's in a parallel program and accelerated time frame. The ABMS also provides more focused advising, preparing the student for graduate study during their sophomore and junior years. The ABMS program develops a close working relationship between the student and a graduate advisor early in the student's academic career. Eligibility requires ME majors to be within 30–45 credit hours of graduating and have a WSU GPA of 3.250 or better.
