

BA in Political Science

Program Requirements

A minimum total of 120 credit hours is required for the BA in political science. In addition to meeting the requirements of the WSU General Education Program (<http://catalog.wichita.edu/undergraduate/academic-information/general-education-program/>) and the requirements of Fairmount College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, students must meet the following requirements:

A major consists of the following five required courses (15 credit hours) and an additional six elective courses (<http://catalog.wichita.edu/undergraduate/courses/pols/>) (18 credit hours) in political science at the 300-level or above.

Departmental Honors

In order *to be admitted* to the political science honors track, students must:

- Be a political science major,
- Receive an A or A- in two of our core courses (POLS 121, POLS 220, POLS 226), and
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.000 or better.

In order *to graduate with* departmental honors, students must:

- Have a 3.500 average GPA for in their POLS classes, and
- Complete an additional applied learning experience beyond POLS 600 (internship, co-op, model UN, research assistantship).

Applied Learning

Students in the Bachelor of Arts in political science program are required to complete an applied learning or research experience to

graduate from the program. The requirement can be met by completing POLS 600.

Additional applied learning experiences include POLS 153 Model United Nations I, POLS 353 Model United Nations II and POLS 490 Internship in Government/Politics.
