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## BBA - Economics Emphasis in Real Estate

## **Program Requirements**

A minimum total of 120 credit hours is required for the Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) in economics emphasis in real estate. In addition to meeting the requirements of the WSU General Education Program (http://catalog.wichita.edu/undergraduate/academic-information/general-education-program/) and the requirements for all BBA programs (http://catalog.wichita.edu/undergraduate/w-frank-barton-business/bachelor-of-business-administration/) set by the W. Frank Barton School of Business, candidates for the BBA in economics emphasis in real estate must satisfy the following requirements of the curricular major:

All majors must contain at least 12 unduplicated credit hours. All minors must contain at least 3 unduplicated credit hours.

Of the 24 credit hours required for the economics emphasis in real estate major, 12 credit hours must come from ECON courses and 12 credit hours must come from RE courses. Urban Economics ( RE 709/ECON 709) may be counted as either an ECON or RE class.

## **Applied Learning**

Students in the BBA in economics emphasis in real estate program are required to complete an applied learning or research experience to graduate from this program. The requirement can be met by completing

ECON 301 Intermediate Macroeconomics, which includes an applied research project.
